### Lesson 1

## Luke 9:23

"Who ever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me."

Today many Christians see the cross as a demonstration of their salvation. The cross may even be the cornerstone of their alliance to Christ. Yet, when Christ spoke this He meant this to convey the truth to take up your cross and follow me. The death by crucifixion, during this Roman occupation was the most humiliating and difficult means to die, at that time. As Christ, anyone, sentenced to die by crucification meant that the individual was given the task to carry their heavy cross. Then be spat upon and humiliated through a long procession to the death. Often spat upon and mocked the individual was humiliated.

And so when Christ says to take up their cross and follow me it is meant to convey the death of self. Just what is self and what is meant by killing self. Self is the fallen nature of man or woman commonly referred to as the ego. With in self lies all the nature at the "fall" of man and woman. The security


instinct within this framework of ego and when threatened retaliates and seeks to find security. Within the ego resides the instinct of security, sex and social norms. Fear is its number one characteristic combined with pride.


So Christ is asking us to allow this self, this ego to die and follow him with our true nature. Our divine nature, or image of Christ is our soul. Our divine nature, too has characteristics, described best for us in Galatians 5:22.

So we bear the cross and seek for self to die, so that our true nature, our divine nature may so shine. This is a daily process. And an understanding of this verse truly separates the church goer, the nominal Christian to what we commonly refer a disciple. Of course, today many church goers enjoy the idea that they mistakenly believe themselves disciples. Yet few truly follow Christ. Most are not able to differentiate through divine nature or trueself from




their fallen natures. They may be born again yet, do not learn the art of Holy Listening. Therefore they are never completely sure which inner voice the listen too. What does all this have to do with taking up your cross and dying daily?

Because this is what Christ is asking you to do. Die to self. Notice the little "s" is used in referring to your ego self and "S" is referred to as your true Self or divine nature.

Remember be still and know I am God. By learning the art of Holy Listening you will gain your inner voice and be a son of God. Keep striving friend by asking the Lord to reveal to you your ego-self or fallen nature. Ask Christ to purify your self. Grow in the death of self. Then you will know and comprehend how to "die daily" and follow Christ as a disciple.

## Luke 14:33

## "So likewise no one of you can be my disciple who does not give up all his own possessions."

So what are you holding unto that prevents you from being a true disciple. Perhaps you hold unto your canal nature as you mistakenly believe you derive pleasure from your carnal nature.

Have you asked Christ to reveal this to you? Say, "Lord reveal to me what caused this gulf, this divide between us?

Perhaps you are attached to a very destructive marriage. You illusion-ally believe you are called to stay married, yet it is a marriage of literal hell. Pray and seek the Lord and grow in discipleship.


So ask the Lord, "Father God, what am I holding unto that is causing a gulf between us." Then listen and He will answer you grow in the art of Holy Listening.




What ever the case may be forsake all to follow Jesus. Be attached to Christ and "seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His righteous, and those things will be added unto you.


### Prayer and Meditation

### A Daily Devotional





We need to watch our prayers as well as watch for the answers to our prayers. It requires as much wisdom to pray rightly as it does faith to receive the answers to our prayers.

Get alone, grow in this solitude and know Christ. Lose you life, at least, the life you think you have and instead be caught up in Christ's plan for your life.


Now friend, do not turn back, grow in this divine friendship. For Christ is the nearest of near and the dearest of dear. There is His power, no relationship that is greater.



### SPURGEON'S CORNER



### Cast thy burden upon the Lord, and He shall sustain thee Psalm 55:22

Care, even though exercised upon legitimate objects, if carried to excess, has in it the nature of sin. The precept to avoid anxious care is earnestly inculcated by our Saviour, again and again; it is reiterated by the apostles; and it is one which cannot be neglected without involving transgression: for the very essence of anxious care is the imagining that we are wiser than God, and the thrusting ourselves into his place to do for him that which he has undertaken to do for us. We attempt to think of that which we fancy he will forget; we labour to take upon ourselves our weary burden, as if he were unable or unwilling to take it for us. Now this disobedience to his plain precept, this unbelief in his Word, this presumption in intruding upon his province, is all sinful. Yet more than this, anxious care often leads to acts of sin. He who cannot calmly leave his affairs in God's hand, but will carry his own burden, is very likely to be tempted to use wrong means to help himself. This sin leads to a forsaking of God as our counsellor, and resorting instead to human wisdom. This is going to the "broken cistern" instead of to the "fountain;" a sin which was laid against Israel of old. Anxiety makes us doubt God's lovingkindness, and thus our love to him grows cold; we feel mistrust, and thus grieve the Spirit of God, so that our prayers become hindered, our consistent example marred, and our life one of self-seeking. Thus want of confidence in God leads us to wander far from him; but if through simple faith in his promise, we cast each burden as it comes upon him, and are "careful for nothing" because he undertakes to care for us, it will keep us close to him, and strengthen us against much temptation. "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on thee, because he trusteth in thee."

### Be zealous Revelation 3:19



## Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, be ever zealous therefore and repent.

If you want to see souls converted, if you want to hear the cry that "the kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord,"1 if you want to place crowns upon the head of the Savior and see His throne lifted high, then be filled with zeal. For under God, the way the world will be converted is by the zeal of the church. Every element of grace will do its work, but zeal will be first; prudence, knowledge, patience, and courage will follow in their places, but zeal must lead the charge. It is not the extent of your knowledge, though that is useful, it is not the extent of your talent, though that is not to be despised, it is your zeal that will do great exploits.

This zeal is the fruit of the Holy Spirit: It draws its vital force from the continued operations of the Holy Spirit in the soul. If our inner life dwindles, if our heart beats slowly before God, we will not know zeal; but if everything inside is strong and vigorous, then we cannot but feel a loving urgency to see Christ's kingdom come, and His will done on earth, even as it is in heaven.


A deep sense of gratitude will nourish Christian zeal. When we reflect on the miry pit from which we were lifted, we find plenty of reason for spending ourselves for God. And zeal is also stimulated by the thought of the eternal future. It looks with tearful eyes down to the flames of hell, and it cannot sleep: It looks up with anxious gaze to the glories of heaven, and it cannot stay still. It feels that time is short compared with the work to be done, and therefore it devotes all that it has to the cause of its Lord. And it is continually strengthened by remembering Christ's example. He was clothed with zeal as with a cloak. How swift the chariot-wheels of duty went with Him! He never loitered on the way. Let us prove that we are His disciples by displaying the same spirit of zeal.




